MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

The position requires graduation from high school or possession of a New York State equivalency diploma **AND** a minimum of three (3) years of full-time paid experience in work involving at least two (2) of the following trades: plumbing, carpentry, electrical, HVAC, painting, masonry, etc.

- Performs routine maintenance and service on HVAC systems
