His diverse educational background and experiences will be a wonderful asset to our district as Superintendent. He has been successful overseeing multiple grade levels and is a strong proponent of open communications with students, staff and the community. Mr. Carter's collaborative leadership style and previous experiences will benefit all of our students, school personnel, and parents while supporting the Wilson community as a whole."

Tim Carter stated, "I am overjoyed and humbled to be selected as the next Superintendent of the Wilson Central School District. Wilson has a rich history of academic excellence and a community that believes in the school focus for striving for excellence. The community is ready to support the schools in preparing the students for the future.
